



Therefore, regulations on the use of green claims are becoming more important



- Creating trust for consumers
- Helping the consumer to make more responsible purchasing decisions
- Fighting against greenwashing and speaking one language
- Improving legal certainty of green claims
- Helping to accelerate the transition to a bioeconomy and circular economy


The Green Claims Directive from the European Commission



With the EU Green Claims Directive, the European Commission is committed to empower **consumers** to make **better informed choices** and play an active role in the ecological transition.

- ISCC has analysed the proposal (report)
- Requirements for environmental labelling schemes are mostly already in place at ISCC
- Some open questions regarding the recognition of schemes, implementation of claims and requirements on wording, etc.





General requirements for the use of ISCC logos and claims

- Claims must be clear and easy to understand
- Reference to the **certified part** of the product
- Correct wording for when mass balance is applied (e.g. supporting, sourcing recycled material)
- The raw material category should be mentioned
- The certified percentage must be included
- →ISCC claims need to be **approved by ISCC**
- → Guidance document "ISCC 208 Logos and Claims"

Ferrero Sustainability Report 2022

In 2022, the Ferrero Cork plant achieved ISCC PLUS certification¹⁵ to pilot the mass-balance approach for recycled plastic from chemical recycling.

Our first pilot in chemically recycled plastic from mass-balance adoption in plastic packaging is with the Tic Tac brand. Tic Tac is using 50% recycled plastic (based on mass balance) for the Tic Tac 200-pill box in our Cork plant.


WHAT IS ISCC?

International Sustainability & Carbon Certification (ISCC) is a globally applicable sustainability certification system and covers all sustainable feedstocks.

From feedstock conversion into biobased plastic, to brush head manufacturing and finally packaging, to ensure that biobased mass balance certified material is properly utilized across Oral-B Brush Heads.



Oral-B explains how the certified material is allocated to the toothbrush heads via ISCC mass balance

KitKat introduces ISCC certified wrappers linked to 90% recycled plastic (mass balance approach)

ISCC Certified

Our Kitkat wrappers with 90% recycled plastic are ISCC certified. The recycled material is allocated using the ISCC mass balance approach. ISCC is International Sustainability & Carbon Certification: it is a system that supports new recycling technologies that transform hard to recycle materials into new plastic, working towards a circular economy.

This means our Kitkat wrappers are made using a mix of virgin and recycled plastics. Each wrapper may vary in the total amount of recycled plastic it contains - some may contain more some may contain less. The process is certified by ISCC to ensure that a minimum of 90% recycled material is allocated to the entire batch of KitKat wrappers (mass balance approach).

BRITA's filter cartridge and filter jug are supporting the sourcing of bio-attributed plastic (60%, 50%, mass balance)











Ferrero's TicTac packaging is linked to ISCC certified recycled plastic (50%, mass balance approach)

ATP Test (Kikkoman A3) is an environmental hygiene monitoring test. The swabs are intended for **one-time use** and were transitioned to 100% bio-based plastic as a result.



The ISCC licensing scheme for brand owners



- The supplier of the ISCC certified final product
 - holds a valid ISCC certificate at the time of delivery AND
 - issues ISCC Sustainability
 Declarations for each batch
 of delivery to the licensee



- The licensee receives an ISCC certified final product that
 - is filled or packed by the licensee
 - which cannot be fundamentally altered by the licensee



- The licensee is
 - a brand owner at the end of the supply chain under whose brand name the finished good goes into the market



Applicable licensing setup - example



The **brand owner** would like to make claims about ISCC certified materials. They **receive a certified finished good/packaging** with the ISCC on-product logo and/or on-product claim.





All licensed finished goods are published in the ISCC license database





Licensing application process

Application

The company applies for the licensing scheme on the ISCC website

2

ISCC Review

ISCC will internally review the request and may ask for additional information 3

License Agreements

ISCC sends the masterand individual agreement(s) to the licensee to be signed 4

License Database

The finished goods of the licensee will be published in the license database. The licensee is allowed to use the ISCC logo (upon approval by ISCC!)



Annual report on sales

The licensee reports its amount of certified incoming material and certified outgoing finished good/packaging to ISCC annually
