





Pilot audits are essential tools to ensure a workable certification approach for RFNBOs

- Since the first drafts of DAs in spring 2022, ISCC was involved in pilot audits, e.g initiated by the Dutch authorities (RVO**). A report has been published (see screenshot on the left)
- In the last years, many other pilots have been conducted also in collaboration with Meo Carbon Solutions

Why pilot audits?

- Companies can benefit from pilot audits in the context of setup eligibility, electricity sourcing, GHG calculation
- At early stages, eligibility for certification of certain setups must be showed off-takers, investors, stakeholders
- Pilot audits acts also as knowledge transfer tools to ISCC to implement and further refine the certification approach






Certificates have been issued under the DK pre-recognition. After recognition more certificates are in the pipelines







To cover RFNBO supply chains renewable electricity units are added to the existing scopes



ISCC is fully ready to certify RFNBOs under the ISCC EU scheme – guidance documentation and procedures are in place







2.	Traceability	Within Chapters No. 2, 3 and 4 the risk of a flawed documentation has to be evaluated. The risk level determines the audit intensity	High	The documents of three successive months should be checked completely
3.	Mass Balance		Medium	The documents of one month should be checked completely and random samples should be taken from three successive months
4.	Greenhouse Gas Emissions	Calculation of actual values	Not applicable	
5.	Sourcing renewable electricity	Check of requirements for counting sourced electricity as fully renewable	Not applicable

 - Tailored ISCC EU RFNBOs System documents
 - Audit procedures
 - Traceability documents (e.g. PoS)

- Other ISCC EU System Documents (e.g. on traceability and Chain-of-Custody) apply



RFNBOs Trainings and TC RFNBOs are key ingredients for a credible and robust certification system

Deploying auditor capacity worldwide



- ISCC has already successfully delivered three ISCC RFNBOs Trainings
- A total of 117 auditors are now in the position to conduct audits in the ISCC EU RFNBOs space
- Next training scheduled on 6 March 2025

Stakeholder engagement and dialogue



- ISCC has already sucesfully organized one RFNBOs Event and one Technical Stakeholder Meetings on RFNBOs, with more than 10 external speakers
- Overall, 660+ individuals participated to those events

ISCC registration and certification process







ISCC Integrity Assessments

- Complete audits or specific focus (CoC, GHG etc.)
- ISCC Integrity Auditors
- Choice of Candidates
 - Randomly / risk basis after risk evaluation
 - complaints
 - Report of non-conformity or fraud
- On a global scale
- On-site/remote
- Results documented in Audit Report
- Consequences: Conditions for recertification, sanctions (e.g. suspension, withdrawal of certificate)



Why ISCC for RFNBOs?

- ISCC is fully ready to certify RFNBOs under the ISCC EU scheme at worldwide level
- ISCC brings 15 years of experience in the sustainable fuels certification sector
- PtX solutions were and are already certifiable under the ISCC PLUS scheme

- Many companies benefited from pilot audits to check certification eligibility
- RFNBOs Trainings and TC RFNBOs are in place and operative
- Overall, ISCC offers certification schemes used by all relevant players in many different markets
